Mass NOW's 2019 Feminism in Action Contest

Feminism in Action Contest: Goals

The Feminism in Action Contest seeks to inspire young feminists to use \$3,000 in grant funds to improve the lives of women and girls by creating an education-based project in Massachusetts.

The Massachusetts Chapter of the National Organization for Women (Mass NOW) is the largest multi-issue feminist organization in Massachusetts. We work every day on Mass NOW's six priority issue areas: (1) constitutional and civil rights; (2) reproductive and health rights; (3) racial justice; (4) LGBTQ rights; (5) violence against women; and (6) economic equality.



Feminism in Action projects must relate to one or more of Mass NOW's priority issue areas. Some examples include: creating a public education media campaign on transgender equal rights, creating a board game to encourage women to run for office, #DATMLNNTHO photography series, and The Feminist Guide podcast. The possibilities are endless!

Feminism in Action Contest: Prizes

- The winner will receive Mass NOW support to implement the project, which includes:
 - · · Dedicated funds, up to \$3,000
 - · · Professional mentorship
 - · · Board support
 - Publicity throughout Mass NOW's networks
- •• The winner will receive an award at Mass NOW's 2019 Feminist Affair, which will take place in the fall
- be invited to work with Mass NOW's board members following the project's completion on a variety of issues (including joining event committees, testifying before the Massachusetts legislature, and judging next year's Feminism in Action Contest just to name a few!)

Feminism in Action Contest: Application Requirements

- Applicant(s) must be 30 years old or younger at the time of entering the contest.
- Applicant(s) must live in Massachusetts during the time of the project's implementation.
- •• Material must be the original work of the applicant(s).
- Applicant(s) must agree to submit a written report at the conclusion of the project, along with providing informal quarterly updates.
- -- Submissions must include the following:
 - 1. Executive Summary (1/2 page max):
 - Summarize your entire project, the problem it seeks to address and the proposed solution.
 - o Be sure to highlight:
 - Originality of your ideas and how it aims to inspire others.
 - How your proposal relates to Mass NOW's priority issue area(s).
 - Breadth of impact of your project on the identified social problem.
 - Permanence of your work following the project's conclusion.
 - 2. Statement of Need (1/2 page max):
 - o What issues does this project intend to address?
 - Why is this project necessary on a community-wide basis?
 - O Why is this issue particularly important to you?
 - 3. Project Description (1 page max):
 - Describe the nuts and bolts of how the project will be implemented and evaluated.
 - Provide an implementation plan, including a description of the types of materials and/or labor that will be needed to execute the project.
 - How should the success of the project be evaluated? (i.e. number of events, number of participants, etc.)
 - o What is the projected timeline?
 - o Who is the intended audience?
 - 4. Budget and Calendar (2 pages max):
 - Provide a financial description of the project, with explanatory notes as necessary.
 - How will the contest proceeds be used to implement the project? (Proposed budget must not exceed \$3,000.)
 - o Provide a month-by-month breakdown of the

implementation of your project for the grant term, which runs from **November 1, 2019-October 31, 2019**.

- 5. Mentorship (1 paragraph max):
 - Mass NOW has connections with feminists in nearly every profession imaginable.
 - Tell us what kind of mentor support would be most helpful for you (lawyer, professor, policy expert, accountant, etc.).
- 6. Completed registration form (attached below).
- 7. Deadline: The final deadline to apply is **August 31st, 2019** at 11:59 p.m.

Feminism in Action Contest: Judging Criteria

- •• Degree of relationship to Mass NOW's priority issue area(s).
- · · Originality of ideas and ability to inspire others.
- -- Breadth of impact on the identified social problem.
- · · Permanence of the work.
- Effectiveness of implementation plan, including the feasibility of the project to be completed successfully within the budget and timeline.
- Potential for success, as evaluated by the criteria proposed by the applicant.
